• **COVID-19**:

- <u>PHASE 1</u>: Coronavirus Preparedness and Response Supplemental Appropriations Act - \$8.3 billion in COVID-19 response funding for developing a vaccine and preventing further spread of the virus. Became law on 3/6/20
- <u>PHASE 2</u>: Families First Coronavirus Response Act \$100 billion in worker assistance, including emergency paid sick leave, food assistance, and unemployment payments. Became law on 3/18/20
- <u>PHASE 3</u>: CARES Act \$2 trillion for loans and support to major industries, including airlines and small businesses, Direct payments to individuals and families. Became law on 3/27/20
- <u>PHASE 4</u>: The House passed the \$3 trillion HEROES Act and the Senate will start working on a "final rescue package" in late July.

FY 2021 Appropriations

- o House
 - Approved by the House -7/24
- o Senate
 - ✤ Markups have slipped and could likely be delayed until September

Looking Forward

- Congressional offices have limited staff
- Virtual advocacy



COVID-19 Supplemental Request

- BAA Requested \$380 million
 - \$300 million for NIFA Research included in the broader \$26 billion request
 - ✤ Hatch \$85 million
 - Evans-Allen \$36.2 million
 - McIntire-Stennis \$11.8 million
 - Tribal Research \$5 million
 - ♦ AFRI \$150 million
 - Federal Administration \$12 million
 - \$80 million for Cooperative Extension
 - ♦ Smith-Lever \$63 million
 - ✤ 1890s Extension \$11.5 million
 - ✤ NTAE \$5.5 million (\$1.5 million to 1994s)

- 1994 Payments \$6,000,000
