Land/Solid Waste -Disposal of feathers/offal

- Be Good Steward of Land
 - Protect public health; Avoid nuisance conditions
 - Protect groundwater and streams
- Honor "Special Waste" Requirements
 - Difficult or dangerous to manage
 - Assists Landfill Operators
 - Defined or Per Discretion of EFO
- Utilize Composting By Rule
 - Obtain permit if required; some exemptions apply
 - Meet "General Facility Requirements"

Air Pollution Control - disposal by incineration

- Protect Air Quality Attainment Goals For Your Area
- Inquire Regarding Permitting
 - Some exemptions apply
 - Exemption is function of several factors
 - Parts of several rules may apply (30 chapters)

Water Resourcesdisposal/management of water

- Maintain or improve waters of the state to maintain designated uses:
 - Potable water supply
 - Industrial water supply
 - Fish and aquatic life
 - Recreation (fishing/swimming)
 - Livestock watering and Wildlife
 - Irrigation
 - Trout habitat

When Water Quality Permits Are Required

- For discharging to waters or land
 - Surface water: NPDES (National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System under Water Quality Control Act)
 - Land: <u>SOP</u> (State Operation Permit) or <u>SSDS</u>
 (Subsurface Sewage Disposal System aka Septic Sys.)
 - Groundwater: <u>UIC</u> (Underground Injection Control under Water Supply Act)
- For operating a sewerage system
- For a new structure constructed with the expectation of generating wastewater

Step 1: Planning

- Know Your Intent
 - Sewerage system permit applications reflect intent
 - Sewerage system permits are developed based on intent
- Develop Your Plan
 - Is wastewater sewage?
 - Is wastewater product?
- Apply Your Plan/Assume Responsibility For It
- Avoid Discharging to Waters

Some Examples

- Can a processor pull the waste water behind the tractor and pump out on growing crops?
 - Waste disposal?
 - Soil amendment?
 - Impact waters?
- Can a processor pump the liquid effluent and use to wet composted material?
 - Waste disposal?
 - Raw material used in making product?
 - Impact waters?

Step 2: Engineering

- Subsurface Disposal (Septic Systems)
- Title 68 of TN Code
- Installed by State-Licensed Installers
- Rules Specify Design Requirements

- Surface Disposal
- Title 69 of TN Code
- PE Registered in TN plans, designs, oversees construction and startup of system
 - Engineering Report
 - Construction Plans
 - Performance Bond

Step 3: Permitting

Septic System:

- Construction Permit
 - Application to local health department w/fee (\$500.00)
- UIC Permit
 - Application to
 Nashville central
 office; \$100.00 annual
 maintenance fee

Surface Land Disposal:

- State Operation Permit
 - Application to Nashville
 Central office; \$350.00
 annual maintenance fee

Water Resources Contacts

- Environmental Field Office
 - Contact & initiate site-specific discussions
 - Will make referral as appropriate
 - Local health department (subsurface)
 - Central office (state operation permit & UIC permit)
