SOCIOECONOMIC PROFILES FOR COUNTIES SERVED BY 4-H TECH CHANGEMAKERS

July 2021

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University of Tennessee Extension is partnering with 4-H Tech Changemakers to implement programs in distressed communities served by 4-H Youth Development. The goal of the 4-H Tech Changemakers program is to provide employable digital skills training to adults using teens as instructors. This program complements efforts by UT Extension to tackle the digital divide through the Digital Literacy for Tennessee and Mobile Hot Spot Lending programs.

Overview

This publication provides 2019 socioeconomic data for 160 counties across 17 states: Alabama, with 26 counties; Arizona, with 11 counties; Arkansas, with 11 counties; Florida, with seven counties; Georgia, with 18 counties; Kentucky, with eight counties; Louisiana, with five counties; Mississippi, with six counties; Nebraska, with nine counties; New York, with four counties; North Carolina, with four counties; Tennessee, with 10 counties; Texas, with seven counties; Virginia, with five counties; Washington, with six counties; West Virginia, with 17 counties; and Wisconsin, with six counties, all served by the 4-H Tech Changemakers program. The source of the data is the 2010 and 2019 American Community Survey conducted by the United States Census Bureau with selected tables hyperlinked below in Table 1. Each factsheet provides data from the target county compared to its state, depicting six variables as shown in Table 1.

Applications and Further Use

Community leaders may use this data to target key areas of improvement, understand the socioeconomic situation of the average household within the community, and to make better informed decisions when implementing policies or programs. Additionally, a community may use this information to demonstrate socioeconomic hardships when applying for grants or funding.
