ALL GRASS TYPES

- Set goals/objectives for coming season.
- What were the issues last year? Weeds? Diseases? Insects?

BERMUDAGRASS/ZOYSIAGRASS

- Window to control winter weeds with non-selective herbicide.
 - Only apply non-selective herbicide when bermudagrass is completely dormant and air temperatures are greater than 55 degrees F.

HOME MAINTENANCE

- Set S.M.A.R.T. goals for home improvement projects:
 - Specific
 - Measurable
 - Achievable
 - Relevant
 - Timely
- Locate and assess water valve to ensure it is operational.

ALL GRASS TYPES

- Select/acquire preemergence (PRE) herbicide to control summer weeds, particularly crabgrass.
 - Look for herbicides that include active ingredients such as dithiopyr, pendimethalin or prodiamine.
- Have soil tested to determine nutrient needs and build fertilizer program.
 - Visit soillab.tennessee.edu
 - Select/acquire fertilizer needed based on soil test results.
- Have mower serviced for coming season, particularly blades (or reels and bedknives) sharpened and oil changed.

HOME MAINTENANCE

- Check water heater for corrosion or leaks.
 - Drain water heater.
- Check electrical service panel breakers to make sure they will trip when necessary.

ALL GRASS TYPES

- Apply PRE herbicide when soil temperature averages 55 degrees F at a 2-inch depth for several consecutive days. Forsythia plants will begin to produce yellow blooms at these soil temperatures and provide a visual cue of when to make an application.

TALL FESCUE

- Control winter broadleaf weeds with selective herbicides. Make applications at air temperatures greater than 55 degrees F. There are numerous options to choose from with many containing multiple active ingredients (e.g., 2,4-D + MCP + dicamba).
- Apply granular fertilizer containing at least 30 percent of the total nitrogen in slow-release form according to soil test recommendations.
- Begin mowing according to one-third rule.

BERMUDAGRASS/ZOYSIAGRASS

- Control winter broadleaf weeds with selective herbicides. Make applications at air temperatures greater than 55 degrees F. Be sure to select herbicides safe for use on warm-season turfgrass transitioning out of winter dormancy.

HOME MAINTENANCE

- Remove dead and fallen trees and limbs.
- Clean the gutters, gutter strainers, and downspouts.

ALL GRASS TYPES

- Crabgrass typically germinates during early to mid-April, so make sure initial PRE herbicide applications have been made before germination.
- Complete an irrigation audit if applicable to make sure there is adequate coverage and everything is running properly.

TALL FESCUE

- Apply fertilizer if needed.
- Mow according to one-third rule.

BERMUDAGRASS/ZOYSIAGRASS

- Consider mowing lawn and collecting clippings to remove dormant biomass, which will accelerate green-up process by facilitating soil warming.

HOME MAINTENANCE

- Try “green cleaning” alternatives for your spring cleaning.
- Test all smoke alarms and carbon monoxide alarms.
- Inspect the roof and exterior walls.
 - Keep an eye out for grainy and peeling shingles.
 - Inspect brick mortar.

ALL GRASS TYPES

- Make sequential application of PRE herbicide.
 - Should be applied 6-8 weeks after first treatment of the year.
- Mow according to one-third rule.
- Irrigate only when signs of drought stress are present such as rolled leaves or lingering footprints.

TALL FESCUE

- Select/acquire fungicide for brown patch (*Rhizoctonia solani*) control.
 - Strobilurin fungicides perform well versus this disease. Look for active ingredients that end in "... strobin."

BERMUDAGRASS/ZOYSIAGRASS

- Apply granular fertilizer containing at least 30 percent of the total nitrogen in slow-release form according to soil test recommendations.

HOME MAINTENANCE

- Inspect for termites and other pests in and around the house.
- Have the air conditioner unit inspected.
- Check/ clean patio and porch area.

- Check vent system for debris.
 - Ensure a strong air flow throughout the house.

- Apply fertilizer according to soil test.

HOME MAINTENANCE

- Inspect all flooring and interior walls.
- Look for:
 - Sagging in the floor
 - Cracks in the floor
 - Insect damage
- Check stairways to make sure they are secure.

ALL GRASS TYPES

- Mow according to one-third rule.
- Monitor for armyworms (scout/check for reports in the area).
- Irrigate only when signs of drought stress such as rolled leaves and lingering footprints are present.
- Treat goosegrass and other weeds with postemergence (POST) herbicide if needed.

TALL FESCUE

- Conclude programs for bermudagrass and dallisgrass removal in tall fescue.
- Aerate and overseed to increase tall fescue density.
- Follow all recommendations for establishment of seedling tall fescue.

BERMUDAGRASS/ZOYSIAGRASS

- Begin programs for dallisgrass removal in bermudagrass/zoysiagrass.
 - tiny.utk.edu/SP642
- Mow according to one-third rule.
- Irrigate only when signs of drought stress such as rolled leaves and lingering footprints are present.
- Select/acquire herbicide(s) to control winter weeds, particularly *Poa annua* and broadleaves.

HOME MAINTENANCE

- Check insulation in house attic.
- Check under sinks and behind refrigerator for leaks.
- Ensure tubs, sinks, toilets, walls, and floors are all caulked.

TALL FESCUE

- Fertilize according to soil test recommendations.
- Control winter weeds POST with herbicides.
 - tiny.utk.edu/W205
 - mobileweedmanual.com
- Mow according to one-third rule.
- Irrigate only when signs of drought stress such as rolled leaves and lingering footprints are present.

BERMUDAGRASS/ZOYSIAGRASS

- Apply herbicides to control winter weeds when soil temperature averages less than 70 degrees F at a 2-inch depth for seven days and recent rainfall has moistened the soil.
 - tiny.utk.edu/W205
 - tiny.utk.edu/W203
- Raise mowing height by at least 1/2 inch in preparation for winter dormancy.
- On zoysiagrass, use a strobilurin fungicide to control large patch (*Rhizoctonia solani*). Two applications need to be made 28 days apart when soil temperatures are less than 70 degrees F at a 2-inch depth.

HOME MAINTENANCE

- Secure weather stripping around windows and doors.
- Clean chimneys and make necessary repairs.
- Have heating system inspected.

TALL FESCUE

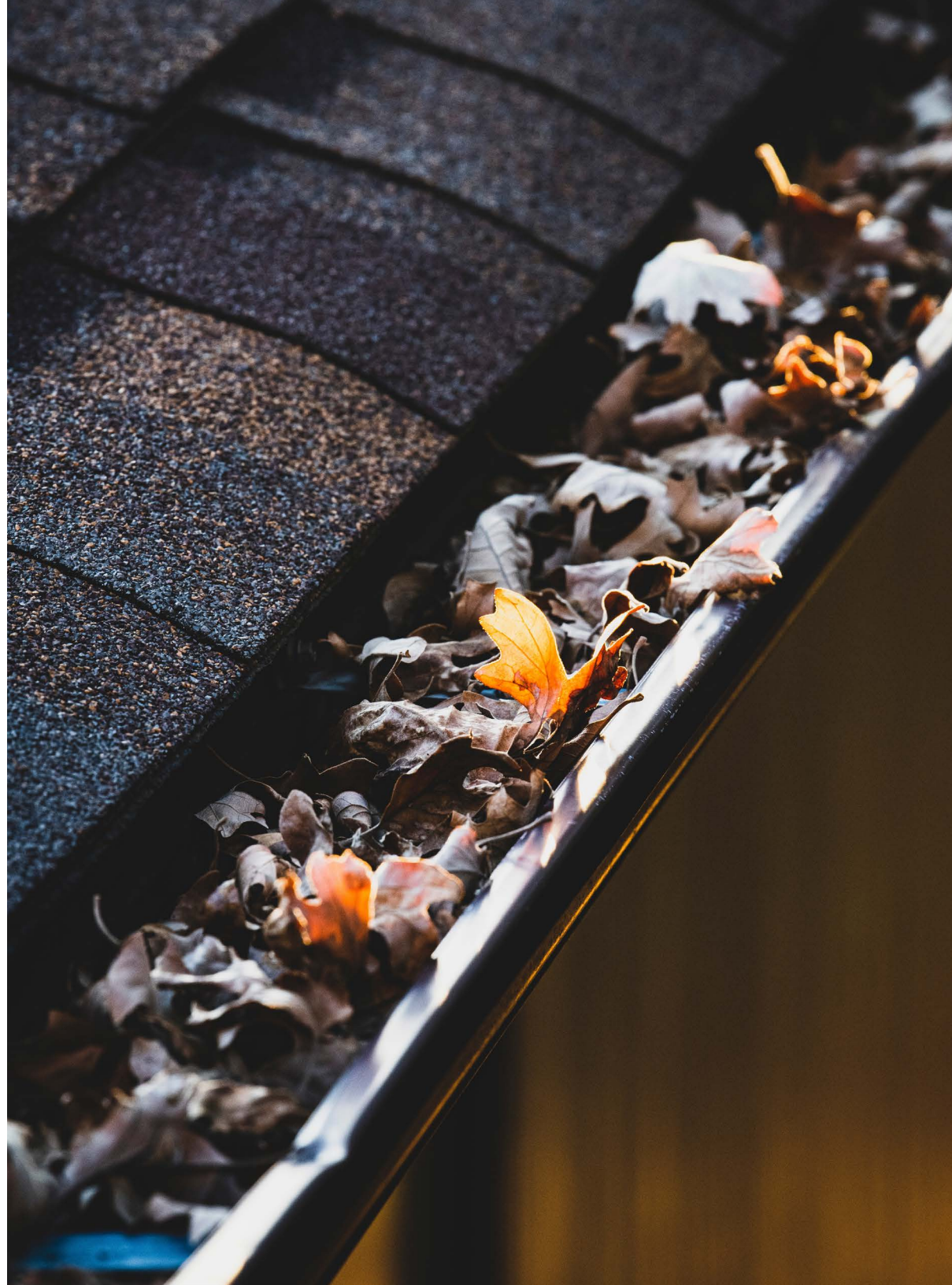
- Fertilize according to soil test recommendations.
- Control winter weeds POST with herbicides.
 - tiny.utk.edu/W205
 - mobileweedmanual.com
- Mow according to one-third rule.
 - Mulch leaves while mowing.
- Irrigate only when signs of drought stress such as rolled leaves and lingering footprints are present.

BERMUDAGRASS/ZOYSIAGRASS

- Conclude programs for dallisgrass removal in bermudagrass or zoysiagrass.
- Mulch leaves while mowing.
- Cease mowing after frost.
- On zoysiagrass, make second application of strobilurin fungicide for large patch (*Rhizoctonia solani*) control.

HOME MAINTENANCE

- Clean downspouts and gutters.
- Insulate all exposed water pipes to prevent freezing.
- Clean hoses and store in a dry place.
