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NEW COMMERCIAL FEED LICENSE APPLICATION
2019 – 2020

Pursuant to T.C.A. §44-6-104, every person who manufactures, distributes, or guarantees commercial feed in Tennessee must obtain a commercial feed license from the Department of Agriculture for each location from where the feed is distributed and must file with the Department an annual statement indicating the number of net tons of commercial feed distributed in the state during the previous calendar year. Fees for the license are determined according to this self-reported data. A commercial feed license is not required for any person who makes only retail sales of feed that is labeled as coming from a licensed manufacturer, distributor, or guarantor.

All current Tennessee Commercial Feed Licenses expire July 1, 2020.

- *Feed previously reported and calculated in a commercial feed license fee;*
- *Feed used as an ingredient in the manufacture of a registered commercial feed;*
- *Customer formula feed composed entirely of commercial feed previously reported and calculated in a commercial feed license fee;*
- *Feed distributed by a contract feeder.*
