

## UTIA Unmanned Aerial Systems (UAS) Operations Approval Form

This approval form must be completed and submitted to the UTIA UAS Coordinating Committee prior to operation. Off-campus UAS operations at UTIA sponsored events and/or by persons working or otherwise representing UTIA must also receive approval before flights may be conducted. It is the operator's responsibility to receive any necessary third-party authorizations for flights conducted off-campus. The UTIA UAS Policy can be reviewed [here](#). # UTIA UAS Approval Form

**Please read and acknowledge the following**

The UAS will not be operated:

- In a manner that violates the UTIA UAS policy, including without limitation, violating federal, state, local laws or FAA regulations (e.g., operational, registration, licensing, and notification requirements) and export control regulations;
- Inside university buildings or facilities
- Above a person who is either not directly participating in the operation of the unmanned aircraft or not located under a covered structure that can provide reasonable protection from a falling unmanned aircraft
- Outside the hours of official sunrise and sunset
- In a manner that substantially disrupts or interferes with UTIA operations, events, or activities
- In a manner or in a place that unreasonably threatens the health or safety of another person
- In a manner that monitors or records an area where a person has a reasonable expectation of privacy
- In a manner or in a place that unreasonably threatens damage to off-campus University or private property
